Christmas Proclamation

Isaiah 52:7-10 MSG

How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of the messenger bringing good news, Breaking the news that all's well, proclaiming good times, announcing salvation, telling Zion, "Your God reigns!" Voices! Listen! Your scouts are shouting, thunderclap shouts, shouting in joyful unison. They see with their own eyes GOD coming back to Zion. Break into song! Boom it out, ruins of Jerusalem: "GOD has comforted his people! He's redeemed Jerusalem!" GOD has rolled up his sleeves. All the nations can see his holy, muscled arm. Everyone, from one end of the earth to the other,

sees him at work, doing his salvation work.

Advent Invitation

We come to this season of Advent and gather around a wreath to light candles. This wreath reminds us of the circle of our human community and the lights that illuminate the many ways in which we bring ourselves to the Incarnation, God's longed-for presence human and holy, Emmanuel - God with us and God coming to us.

Advent Scripture

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was in the beginning with God. ³ All things came into being through him, and without him not one thing came into being. What has come into being ⁴ in him was life, and the life was the light of all people. ⁵ The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overtake it.

Advent Remembrance

We remind ourselves that there has been much light in the world that has been extinguished and we acknowledge that we have let it happen.

We remember hopes that have been extinguished. (*extinguish* candle)

We can barely remember a time of peace. (extinguish candle)

We have tried to protect our own joys and ignored the sorrows of others. (*extinguish candle*)

We have let love go out and have not even lifted a hand to protect the flame. (*extinguish candle*)

Now we have not fresh wicks but crumpled ones, and yet we name and claim this truth: God gives us courage and compassion to relight hope, peace, joy and love in our lives and our times.

(All candles are light)

Advent Candles

We are empowered by the advent of Emmanuel, God with Us, because of whom Isaiah prophesied no bruised reed would be broken nor dimly burning wick quenched until justice fills all that lives and grows.

We light the candle of **Hope** for earth and air and seas, for the creatures dwelling among us and the plants alive with God's Spirit.

We light the candle of **Peace** in the midst of violence and conflict, of fear in home, discord in family and work, terror in the street, controversy that makes strangers from friends, wars that kill God's precious children, and we say that Peace is stronger.

We light candle of **Joy** because we believe that joy, not anger or fear, is the root of all justice.

We light the candle of **Love** because we have met angels and babies, caregivers and wanderers and we have received a light in our lives that we must share with the world.

Emmanuel, we celebrate the Advent of the past with its precious words and traditions, and we light an Advent of new hope, peace, joy, and love for all the seasons of your children. Amen.

The Birth of Jesus

About that time Caesar Augustus ordered a census to be taken throughout the Empire. This was the first census when Quirinius was governor of Syria. Everyone had to travel to his own ancestral hometown to be accounted for. So Joseph went from the Galilean town of Nazareth up to Bethlehem in Judah, David's town, for the census. As a descendant of David, he had to go there. He went with Mary, his fiancée, who was pregnant.

While they were there, the time came for her to give birth. She gave birth to a son, her firstborn. She wrapped him in a blanket and laid him in a manger, because there was no room in the hostel.

An Event for Everyone

There were shepherds camping in the neighborhood. They had set night watches over their sheep. Suddenly, God's angel stood among them and God's glory blazed around them. They were terrified. The angel said, "Don't be afraid. I'm here to announce a great and joyful event that is meant for everybody, worldwide: A Savior has just been born in David's town, a Savior who is Messiah and Master. This is what you're to look for: a baby wrapped in a blanket and lying in a manger."

At once the angel was joined by a huge angelic choir singing God's praises:

Glory to God in the heavenly heights, Peace to all men and women on earth who please him.

As the angel choir withdrew into heaven, the shepherds talked it over. "Let's get over to Bethlehem as fast as we can and see for ourselves what God has revealed to us." All who heard the shepherds were impressed.
